This statement sets out how I handle personal data in the course of my work, in line with the UK GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018.

ICO Registration

I am registered with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) as a data controller, registration reference: **ZC214763**.

What I collect

I process limited personal data, such as the names, contact details, and correspondence of clients, collaborators, and partner organisations, solely for the purposes of delivering contracted work, invoicing, and project administration.

The contact form on this site is processed via Formspree, a third-party form-handling service; submissions (name, email address, and message) are used solely to respond to the enquiry and are not used for marketing or any other purpose. Enquiry data is retained for up to 12 months and then deleted, unless a working relationship develops, in which case data is retained as set out above.

Data I do not hold

Where my work involves environmental or public health data, this is drawn from published, aggregate sources (for example, ONS, DEFRA, or NHS-published statistics) rather than identifiable personal or patient-level records.

How data is handled

Personal data is stored securely, accessed only as needed to deliver agreed work, retained only as long as necessary for that purpose or as required by law, and not shared with third parties beyond what is required to deliver a project, without consent.

Rights and contact

Individuals may contact me at any time to ask what personal data I hold about them, request its correction or deletion, or raise a concern about how it is handled.
